

City Ordinance #1075-05 authorizes issuance of Extended Hours Permits for construction work that may be conducted at times other than those listed below, if there is an emergency condition, or the public peace and quiet will not be unreasonably disturbed. The permit shall be kept on the work site and must be shown to city official on request. **PERMIT FEE \$100.00.**

CONDITIONS FOR AN EXTENDED HOURS PERMIT:

1. Construction noise in the vicinity of the proposed work site would be less objectionable at night than during the day time due to differences in population levels or neighboring activities.
2. Obstruction and interference with traffic, particularly on heavily traveled streets would be less objectionable at night than during the day time.
3. The kind of work to be performed emits noise at such a low level that the noise will not cause a significant disturbance in the vicinity of the work site.
4. Great economic hardship will occur if the work is spread over a longer period of time.
